DIVER'S ENTRY CHECK LIST

1. Tank:
 - B.C./Backpack secure.
 - Air is turned on.
 - Tank Pressure is recorded.
 - "J" valve is down (older tanks)
2. Buoyancy Compensator / B.C.:
 - Inflator hose attached
 - Able to fill B. C.
3. Regulator:
 - Air from primary/octopus
 - Hoses clear.
4. Weight Belt:
 - Clear of hoses
 - Buckle on proper side
 - Properly weighted, weight recorded
5. Mask, Snorkel, Fins: OK
 - Mask under hood, good seal, straps OK
6. Knife:
 - Secure / Clear
7. Suit:
 - Zippers done up
 - Hood tucked in properly
 - Dry suit whip (hose) connected
8. Buddy Review:
 - Dive Plan / Hand Signals / Equipment Check
9. Check in with the Divemaster / Dive
10. Debrief with Divemaster / Buddy
11. Log Dive
